- **Why do we March?** Even though Roe v. Wade was overturned, there is still a great need to witness to the dignity of all life. Thousands gathered in the nation's capital sends a positive and prayerful message. Traditionally, the March ended at the Supreme Court, but now, we end at the Capitol building to emphasize that each state must continue the work of protecting life at all stages.
- **When is it?** We will depart in the morning on Wednesday Jan. 20th and arrive back in the afternoon on Sunday Jan. 24th.
- **Who can attend?** Students in 9th-12th grade.
- **How much is it?** \$750; paid in three installments. CYO funds can be used. Cost covers flight, hotel, metro and some meals.
- **Are there discounts?** Participation in **SMA CYO fundraisers** can help cover the cost. Final payment can be deferred until after the Fish Fry in March.
- **How do we get there?** We will book a group flight on Southwest Airlines.
- **Why does SMA go separately from the Archdiocese?** Flying to DC allows us to have more time there, see a number of historical sites, and participate in related events. We will make a concerted effort to meet up with the other NOLA groups.
- **Where do we stay?** We will stay in DC near the Capitols stadium.
- **How will we get around?** We use public transportation (metro) and Uber to get to the March and other events.
- **What will we do?** The March is on Friday morning, the 22nd. We will try to attend a rally on the 21st. We visit educational & spiritual sites in DC, including Smithsonian Museums, the Bible Museum, the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, the St. John Paul II National Shrine, Arlington Cemetery, National monuments & more!
